## LOCAL SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

**CHRISTOPHER BANNERMAN MEMORIAL AWARD** – Presented to a senior who has demonstrated determination, dedication to pursue dreams no matter how great the obstacles, a sense of humor, humanitarianism, a desire to work and help others, integrity, high moral standards, compassion, and love of family and community, strength and courage.

**CHIEF ROY BRUCKER SCHOLARSHIP** – In Chief Brucker’s memory, the Collinsville Volunteer Fire Department Inc. and the Canton Memorial Ambulance awards a scholarship to a Canton High School senior who will graduate in the top half of his/her class and displays financial need. The candidate must demonstrate a commitment to community leadership, be of high moral character, and intend to pursue his/her education.

### **CANTON ATHLETIC BOOSTERS SCHOLARSHIP**

The CABC strives to recognize student athletes that demonstrate teamwork, dedication in the classroom and community involvement. We believe that being the best athlete, class leader or most active in the community may not always open doors of opportunities, but to endeavor, to the best of each person's ability will certainly prove immeasurable.

### **CANTON CHAMBER OF COMMERCE SCHOLARSHIP**

The Canton Chamber of Commerce Scholarship will be awarded to one Canton High School senior for post high school continuing education and/or entrepreneurial pursuits. The scholarship will be based on the candidate’s stated interests and intentions to pursue business education and/or entrepreneurship. The scholarship will not be need based. The recipient will be selected by the Canton Chamber of Commerce.

The requirements are as follows:

1. An essay – “Why I should be considered for this scholarship”
2. A letter of recommendation from an unrelated person and
3. An interview with the CCC Scholarship Committee or members of the Board of Directors.

### **THE CAWASA GRANGE EDUCATIONAL GRANT**

1. Active Good Citizenship: (45%)
  - A. Good and effective participation in the non-academic activities of the school and in the religious, fraternal or service organizations of the town.
  - B. Mature leadership in the affairs of at least one such organization.
  - C. Personal, independent contributions of work, attitudes, or character which constitute individual citizenship.

2. Scholastic Promise - this shall be judged in light of the following statement (45%): The individual shall stand in the upper half of his graduating class. He shall be academically ambitious and capable. He need not be an outstanding scholar, preferably, he shall not be receiving other substantial awards.
3. Potential for Service in the Betterment of Mankind (10%): He shall have those qualities of character and personality which, coupled with further education, will make him an able and effective contributor to the progress of his community and nation.

**CAWASA GRANGE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** will be awarded to a student who has been accepted into an accredited college or university.

1. Academic performance: The participant must have obtained a B average for the last four marking periods. A copy of your senior year report card must accompany application.
2. Community service
3. Financial need will be considered.

**SAM COLLINS DAY ART SCHOLARSHIP** is awarded to a graduating senior from Canton High School who plans to continue studying the arts. The candidate must have been accepted to and committed to attending a four-year college, conservatory institute, or an art school with plans to study fine arts or design.

#### **DR. DITERS SCHOLARSHIP**

The Dr. Diters/Canton Community Health Fund Scholarship, established in the name of Dr. Edward Diters and administered through the Health Fund, is awarded to students who intend to pursue an education in a health-related field. The students should also demonstrate high academic achievement and commitment to their community.

**MARIE A. DRAPEAU LITERARY AWARD** – To a graduating senior who has achieved an A or B average, has plans to pursue a degree in the field of education, and enjoys writing.

**KENNETH E. DRS MEMORIAL AWARD** – Mr. Drs was a man who possessed great enthusiasm, energy, tenacity, and caring, and applied these qualities to all his endeavors. This award is presented to a student who exemplifies these same qualities and who will be continuing his/her education.

## **EDUCATION ASSOCIATION OF CANTON**

1. The candidate shall have made application to a school of his choice.
2. The candidate shall rank in the upper third of his class and shall have attended Canton High School for at least two years.
3. The candidate shall be of good moral character.
4. The candidate shall have given evidence of unselfish participation in school, church, or community activities.
5. The candidate shall indicate financial need.

**JULIUS FIALKIEWICZ SCHOLARSHIP** - Awarded to a member of the graduating class who will be attending a trade or technical college. Candidates shall have demonstrated a sense of humor, and be caring, considerate and responsible.

**THE KRZANOWSKI AWARD** presented in honor of Edward F. Krzanowski and Karen Lewis Krzanowski who were known and loved for their concern and service to others, high moral character, and maturity of purpose in their lives. In granting this award, particular consideration is given to individuals who exemplify these qualities in their own lives.

**LIONS CLUB OF CANTON** - Awarded to a member of the graduating class who has displayed and demonstrated active participation in service to our community and has maintained high ethical standards and a good academic standing. The candidates shall have given good and effective participation in community service activities such as fraternal, religious or service organizations. The candidates shall have maintained a good academic standing and have been selected to a college, trade or occupational school. The candidates shall be of good moral character.

**DARREN NEDOVICH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** – Awarded to a student who best exhibits Darren’s traits of perseverance, individuality, loyalty, and whose love and zest for life makes Canton High School a happier place for others. The recipient should also have participated in varsity athletics.
