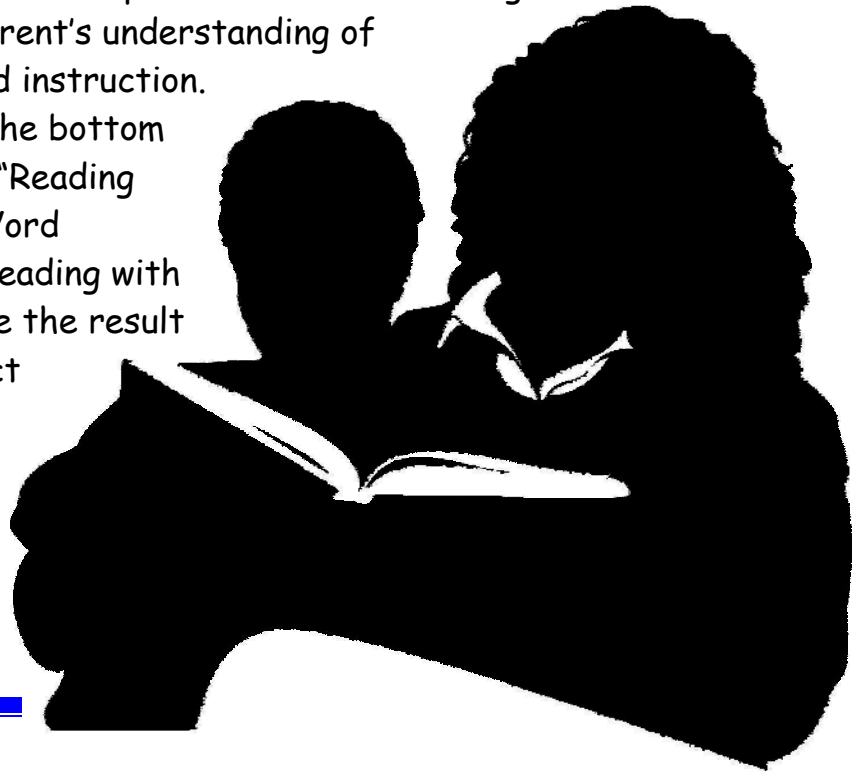


Cherry Brook Primary School has received an **Enhancing Education through Technology Grant** funded by the **State Department of Education through the Capital Region Education Council (CREC)**. As a result of this grant, CBPS will be creating a second series of online digital resources that will provide a means of parent-teacher collaboration in the instruction of reading. These online resources will promote student reading achievement by increasing parent's understanding of comprehension strategies and instruction.
