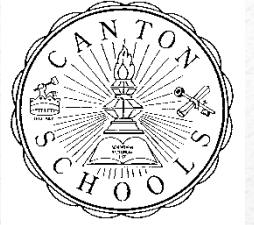

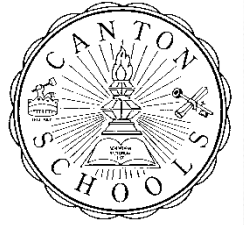


# This Year

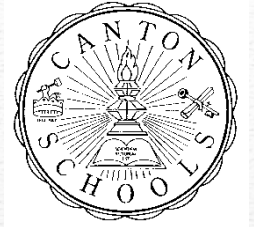

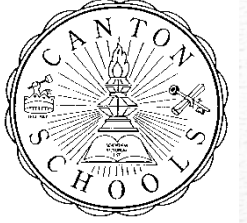
